

# Clinical Assistant/Associate Professor of Pediatrics (Cardiac Psychology)

The Division of Behavioral Medicine and Clinical Psychology at Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center is seeking a clinical faculty position to serve in the **Heart & Mind Wellbeing Center** within the Heart Institute.

This new clinical program provides inpatient, outpatient, group, and telehealthbased psychological services for children, adolescents, and adults with **congenital heart disease** and their families. The clinical service is also fully integrated into our Center's comprehensive research program.

Responsibilities for this position include providing evidence-based clinical care to patients of all ages and stages, their caregivers, and other family members, as well as program development, and co-design of innovative approaches to delivering psychological care embedded within the context of cardiac care.

The ideal candidate will have completed a doctorate in clinical psychology (APA accredited), and be licensed or license-eligible in Ohio, with a preference for candidates with training or experience working with children with congenital heart disease and their families. Candidates from underrepresented groups are encouraged to apply.
